

HOST CITY INFORMATION

Located on the Mediterranean seaside, Marseille is the oldest town in France, founded by Greek sailors in 600 B.C. By now, Marseille is the second town in France and the foremost research, industrial and tertiary pole of the south of France.

The climate is usually sunny in June and temperature from 20° to 25°C. You may get Marseille through Marseille-Provence Airport, the third French airport with a wide connexion system. By railway, Marseilles is at 3 h from Paris, 5h30 from Brussels and 6 h from London.

Forty per cent of the territory of Marseilles is reserved for nature areas, such as the famous Calanques, a highly popular area for walking and sea activities. With its 25 theaters, the Opera, the International Dance School and the National Ballet, Marseille is one of the most cultural cities of France. Social programs will be suggested to make you enjoy the Marseilles city and magnificent surroundings such as Aix-en-Provence, Arles and Cassis.
