WHY JOIN NKF-CNNT?

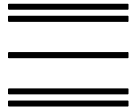

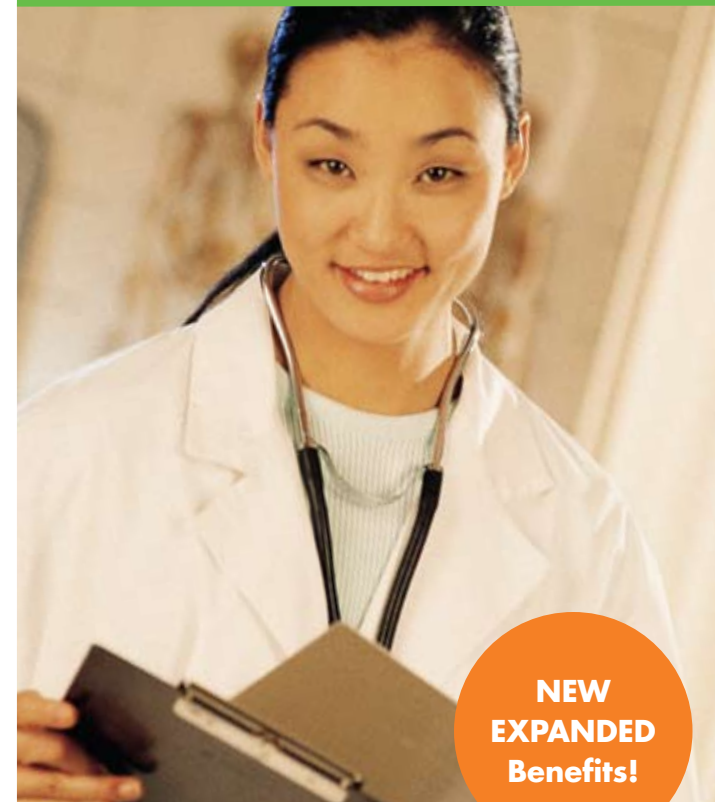

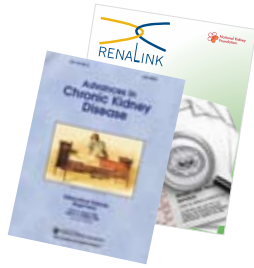
