WHY JOIN NKF-CRN?

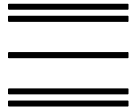

CRN offers frequent opportunities for collaboration and networking with colleagues to improve clinical practice and promote career advancement.

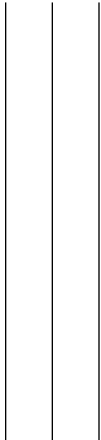

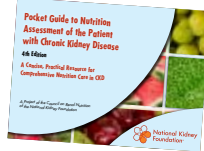
