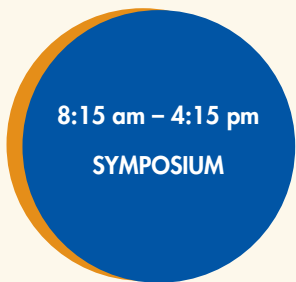
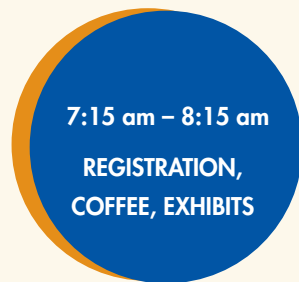

This full-day symposium will focus on the link between cardiovascular disease (CVD), diabetes, and chronic kidney disease (CKD); the clinical and psychosocial complications of hypertension and diabetes for diabetics on dialysis; pediatric nephrolithiasis; bariatric surgery and its nutritional implications in preparation for kidney transplantation; the grief process for CKD patients; diabetic kidney disease; accurate dosing for CKD; the 2011 initiation of bundling; acute kidney failure; mineral disorders in CKD; kidney/pancreas transplantation; and an overview of the conditions of coverage.
