Dear Interested Camp Volunteer:

The National Kidney Foundation (NKF) Serving Ohio and Kentucky Kappa Kidney Camp committee invites you to be a part of a very special program. **Kappa Kidney Camp 2011** will be held **June 26- July 1**, at Recreation Unlimited in Ashley, Ohio. This weeklong summer camp welcomes children ages 8-18 who are on dialysis or who have had a kidney transplant. We hope you will join us to share in this rewarding volunteer experience.

As a Kappa Kidney Camp volunteer, you will have the opportunity to participate in various recreational activities along with approximately 50 pediatric kidney patients. Nurses, physicians, and pharmacists are needed primarily to help administer daily medications and other allied health care professionals assist with delivering medical care for the patients while at camp. Non-medical/general volunteers are needed to participate and encourage campers to try the various camp activities including boating, fishing, swimming; arts and crafts; sports and recreation; and nature education. Whatever your role, you will be responsible for ensuring that each camper has a safe and enjoyable experience at Kappa Kidney camp.

To be eligible to volunteer at Kappa Kidney Camp, please submit the following information (forms enclosed) by May 12, 2011.

- **Two References** (if this is your first time at camp)
- **Confidentiality Agreement**
- **Awareness of Child Abuse**
- **Code of Conduct**
- **Civilian Background Check with Instructions**
NKF Serving Ohio and Kentucky will submit the forms and pay the fee for the background checks.
- **C.V./Resume** (if you are a nurse, social worker, pharmacist, dialysis technician or other health care professional)
