

Policy of Reporting Abuse

1. Anyone can report a suspected case of abuse, whether it is physical, verbal, or sexual abuse.
2. Reports should be directed to the nephrologist on duty, Bill Metzger, or the YMCA camp personnel.
3. If it happens during working hours, contact the local Children's Services Intake in Logan County.
4. If it happens outside the above hours, contact the local police department.
5. Someone will be with the victim at all times till the police arrive. Do not let them shower or clean themselves or change clothes. If the victim needs immediate medical attention, call 911.

7. Patti Gold will then contact the parents.
8. The child will be sent home after the police initial investigation is done.
9. The police department will determine what happens to the accused person.
10. Patti Gold will do any interviews with the media personnel.
11. Provide on-going counseling with the other campers as needed.
