Dr. Kalantar-Zadeh is an Associate Professor of Medicine and Pediatrics and Epidemiology at UCLA David Geffen School of Medicine, and Director of the Dialysis Expansion Program and Epidemiology at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center in Southern California. He received his MD from the University of Bonn in Germany, and a master's degree in Public Health and a PhD in epidemiology from the University of California Berkeley. Dr. Kalantar-Zadeh, a triple board certified specialist, completed his residency in both medicine and pediatrics at the State University of New York at Brooklyn and his nephrology fellowship at the University of California, San Francisco. Dr. Kalantar-Zadeh has authored or coauthored more than 150 original research papers, reviews, and editorials, 10 book chapters, and over 300 abstracts.
