Kidney disease facts:

- 1 in 3 American adults—73 million people—is at risk for kidney disease.
- 1 in 9 American adults—26 million people—has kidney disease—and most don't know it.
- Early detection and treatment can slow or prevent the progression of kidney disease.

Risk factors include:

- Diabetes
- High blood pressure
- Family history of kidney failure
- Age 60 and over
- African American, Hispanic, Asian, American Indian, or Pacific Islander
- Obesity

What to expect at the event:

- Risk survey
- Blood pressure check
- Body mass index (BMI) measurement
- Opportunity to speak with a healthcare professional
- Free educational materials
- And for individuals at risk, an ACR urine test for albumin (a type of protein)
