- Is between 21-39 years-old in Northern OH area
- Has an interest in fundraising and a passion for the NKFs mission
- Junior Board members are expected to attend at least **4** meetings per year, 90 minutes in the evening at a central location near Cleveland
- Members are expected to put in additional time outside of meetings towards the planning, implementation and success of NKF events during tenure
- Members are required to choose a committee on which to serve: Walk Logistics, Golf Classic, Dining with the Stars
- Committed to working network of resources to bring in new partnerships, volunteers, or in kind donations for various events and campaigns. Heavy focus on fundraising, asking for sponsorships, selling tickets to events, etc.
- Committed to a 2 year term; will be eligible to renew membership provided member has met the minimum requirements for board participation
- Suggested annual personal donation to the National Kidney Foundation; may be combined with fundraising through an event or campaign
