

Li-Li Hsiao, MD, PhD **Director. Asian Renal Clinic** Assistant Professor, Harvard Medical School

Dr. Li-Li Hsiao is a Nephrologist and a faculty at BWH. Harvard Medical School. She is the founder of a program called Kldney Disease Screening and Awareness Program (KDSAP), which as been providing kidney health screening in the underserved communities in New England region and nationally, all free of charge. KDSAP has had major contribution in CKD prevention and health disparity since 2018.
