Living Donor Protection Act (S. 377/H.R. 1255)

Support legislation that would prohibit discrimination in the pricing or availability of life, disability or long-term care insurance for living donors. The bill also adds living donation to the Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA).






CARE for Home Dialysis Act

This bill would remove barriers to accessing home dialysis and ensure that all patients are given the opportunity to dialyze on their own time, in the comfort of their own home, if they so choose.




Appropriations

NKF is seeking funding for the Kidney Risk Campaign; \$15 million for CDC's Chronic Kidney Disease Initiative; and additional funding for the National Institutes of Diabetes, Digestive and Kidney Disease (NIDDK).
